## **ADMISSIONS STATEMENT**

Bloomfield is an independent special school for up to 70 students aged 11 to 16 years, who have social, emotional, behavioural and other difficulties or needs.

We will admit children with an Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP) or where the local authority feel we will meet their individual needs.

Referrals are usually made by Local Authorities or Social Services and can be made at any point during the academic year through direct contact with the school.

### **Admission Criteria**

The admission arrangements are determined by the business development team in conjunction with the Headteacher

Following referral, the school will determine if they can meet the needs of the pupil and any additional support necessary. The pupil, carers/parents, social worker and Virtual Headteachers are encouraged to visit the school.

Bloomfield and Dudley Port will admit a pupil whose final EHCP names the school, with our prior agreement.

Bloomfield and Dudley Port will ensure pupils are offered an integration package that starts as soon as possible once a place has been offered.

### **Legislation**

This policy takes account of all relevant legislation including the legislation on sex discrimination, race relations, and disability, together with all relevant regulations and the School Admissions Code.

### **School admissions**

On admission to school the admissions book will be completed and the pupil registered on Integris.
