Forest School creates a safe nurturing environment for learners to try new things and develop new skills. Forest School offers a meaningful connection to the world and the outdoors and an understanding of



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

Lemon Chicken Noodles

This term Food Technology has been recreating dishes from various special dietary requirements. Whilst practising new skills the students got to sample different foods from the various diets and understand why different diets are important.

Moussaka The Ketogenic diet or "keto" diet is a low -carbohydrate, fat-rich eating plan that has been used for centuries to treat specific medical conditions.

poultry, seafood, insects and the flesh of any other animal.)

Crispy Lemon chicken and Noodles The lactose-free diet is a common eating pattern that eliminates or restricts lactose, a type of sugar in milk.

Jamaican Bully Beef and Rice A gluten-free diet is an eating plan that cuts out foods that have a protein in them called gluten. Gluten helps foods keep their shape. It's found in grains

Vegan Jambalaya and Rice Veganism is the practice of abstaining from the use of animal products and the consumption of animal source foods.
