Dear Parents/Carers, we are glad to say that it has been another fantastic term for all students and staff full of opportunities and improvements.

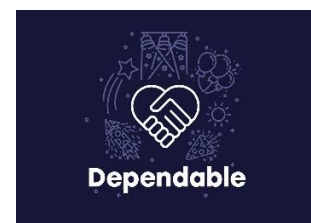
Just like previous terms, our students have consistently learnt and practised their knowledge with **our values** in mind, with each value being celebrated on a weekly basis.
